MEMBER ZOOM NETWORKING: WHAT'S IT ALL ABOUT?

It's a great discussion space to connect with fellow mentors in our network, and share life/ministry experience, articles and resources on a variety of different topics.

In September we tackled the idea of "Mentoring For Fun -Helping Mentorees Have More Fun". A frivolous topic you may think? Certainly not when we understand the context of FUN in its renewing, replenishing and creative purpose, recognising that we neglect and trivialise fun at the risk of our own health and sustainability!

We launched off Catherine Price's TED Talk: 3 elements of true fun - and how to have more of it. (Check it out **here** or search on YouTube). Here are some takeaway points from the session:

- Important element of REST, we are created in the image and likeness of God, and are designed not to work 24/7
- True genuine fun produces a sense of joy
- Fun is a necessity, not a luxury, not an add-on
- Fun is not a reward of labour, but the foundation of labour. We don't have to earn it
- Intentionality of fun construct a fun objective, not related to KPI or job; diarise time for fun to make sure it is a priority
- Model it! Experience it ourselves. Grow our repertoire of fun examples to share. "We teach what we know, but we reproduce what we are" John C. Maxwell
- Be guarded about what we allow in; there are toxic influences all around us; fun is a counteragent
- Some things that prevent us from prioritising renewing fun in our lives? Busyness, Priorities, Digital Saturation. It might be time for a digital fast!
